

Hearings Set On Project Notification Procedure

While no projects are currently proposed, Regional Parks has scheduled public hearings on the procedures to be followed when new projects are proposed, as required by the American River Parkway Plan.

Copies of the procedures have been sent to the Parkway Advisory Committee, and to a long list of people and organizations interested in the Parkway, in preparation for a hearing before the Committee at noon January 16 at the Parkway Foundation Volunteer Center.

The procedures – essentially whom to notify when major projects are proposed, and when and how to do so – will then go before the County Recreation and Park Commission for another hearing on January 22, before going on to the Board of Supervisors for final adoption.
